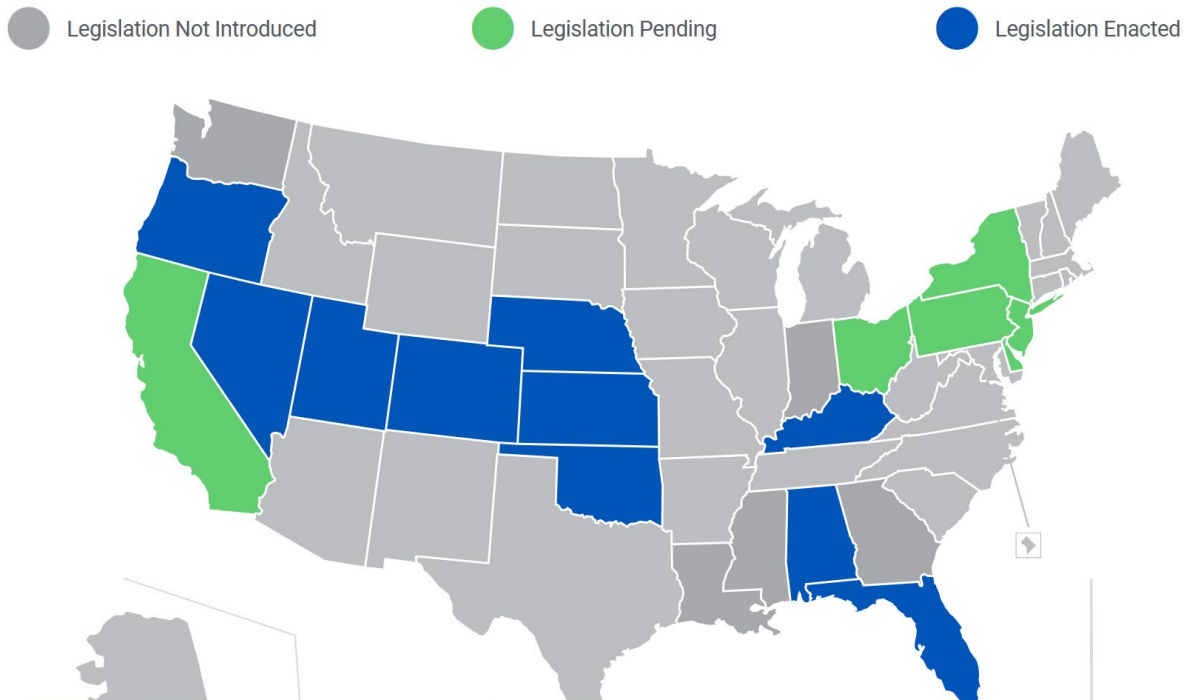


COMPACT MAP

Teachers holding a compact-eligible license can apply for licensure in another member state and receive the closest equivalent license without submitting...

- additional materials
- taking state-specific exams, or
- completing additional coursework.

For a license to be eligible, it must be an “unencumbered license” which means not restricted, probationary, provisional, substitute or temporary.

Step 1: Complete an initial teaching program through FHSU, including passing the PPAT portfolio and passing the Kansas required Praxis subject test.

Step 2: Apply for an Initial Teaching License in Kansas using KSDE Form 1.

Step 3: Once the Kansas license has been issued, apply for a license in one of the compact states and complete their background check.

Step 4: Out-of-state license gets issued!
