### **FACULTY AWARENESS AND USE OF AN INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORY AT A MASTER'S GRANTING UNIVERSITY**

Fort Hays State librarians Mary Elizabeth Turner and Jennifer Sauer recently co-authored an article that was published in the Journal of Librarianship and Scholarly Communications. Their study combined the results of a faculty survey that measured faculty awareness of and participation in the institutional repository (IR) of a single state masters-granting institution with information on content type and downloads to draw conclusions about the composition and usage of the IR at this institution.
