Dr. Marco Macias, assistant professor of history, and Dr. Daniel McClure, assistant professor of history, recently coauthored an article in "Film & History: An Interdisciplinary Journal." The article examines the way historical projections work through the John Wayne film, Undefeated (1969). He argues that the film "possesses" the history of the Reconstruction era by rewriting the racial animosity with an eye toward late 1960s critiques of white supremacy by people of color during the "Second Reconstruction" of the Civil Rights era.
